



Photography/Videography Policy

Sycamore Public Library staff use photographs and videos to help convey the story of the library's impact on the community. Attendance at our programs and events constitutes a consent to be photographed and/or filmed for use in our promotional materials. Names or personally identifying information will not be used without the express permission of the subject or the subject's parent, legal guardian, or caregiver. Participants (or their legal representatives, on their behalf) may opt out of being photographed or filmed by informing the library staff member coordinating the program or event.

Members of the public may take photographs or videos in all public areas of the library provided they are not disturbing others' use of the library. Equipment may not block walkways, obstruct views, or create hazards of any kind. Photographers and videographers must respect others' wishes not to be photographed or filmed and must obtain permission from a parent, legal guardian, or caregiver before photographing or filming anyone under the age of 18. Taking photographs or filming copyrighted (or otherwise protected) materials for the purpose of redistribution is prohibited.
